Incomplete sentences, spelling errors, and poorly thought-out responses will **NEGATIVELY** affect the review of your application. Therefore, to prevent mistakes, it is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** to compose your answers in a word processing program, and then paste them into the application. Be sure to have your parents, high school counselor, or mentor read through your application **PRIOR** to submission.
